Subject: Update: Soil thermal remedy work at Bethpage Community Park

Northrop Grumman is providing this progress report to you on our activities in support of the upcoming soil thermal remedy work at the Bethpage Community Park (Park). Since October 26, 2023, we have been installing the thermal treatment wells to prepare for the second phase of soil treatment.

As we have mentioned during our community meetings, we completed treating the VOC's in soil on the ballfield in the Phase 1 location in 2023. We conducted soil testing in the Phase 2 locations and are installing the ISTR Phase 2 equipment.

While conducting environmental remediation in the Bethpage Community Park under the supervision of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), we discovered several drums encased in concrete underground in a closed area of the Park designated for the Phase 2 VOC soil remediation.

We promptly notified the NYSDEC, and other officials, and we are working with NYSDEC to assess and address this situation as quickly as possible. We remain committed to protecting the health and well-being of the community and to continuing our partnership with NYSDEC and other government regulators to address environmental conditions in the area.
