Subject: Upcoming Road Closure and Traffic Detour on February 24-27, 2026, at Arumdaun Presbyterian Church Vision Center; Temporary closure of Tennis Courts; Creation of safety zone in parking lot nearest Skate Park

Northrop Grumman is providing this progress report to you about our ongoing work at the Bethpage Community Park (Park).

On February 24, 2026, from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m., a temporary closure at the intersection of Access Road and Aerospace Blvd. will be in place. During the closure, contractors will temporarily install a large crane and safety equipment to support the removal of the Phase 2 In-Situ Thermal Remedy (ISTR) system. The crane schedule is subject to change based on progress and unforeseen delays (i.e., weather or mechanical).



During this time, vehicle access to McKay Field Access Road (a main entrance to Arumdaun Presbyterian Church Vision Center) will be altered for specific periods throughout the day.

**Drivers – Please use caution when using the Access Road entrance and reduce your speed as workers will be present with moving equipment on the roadway at times:**

- **On February 24, 2026, from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m.** we will require all passenger vehicles to use the south entrance to access the Vision Center as the access road from Aerospace Blvd. will be temporarily closed as we move equipment, perform safety checks, and secure the crane in place.
- **On February 27, 2026, at 7:30 a.m.** we will redirect traffic to use the south entrance for about one hour to load a truck parked on the access road with the crane.

Northrop Grumman staff will open the gate to the south entrance at 7 a.m. on February 24 and 27 and security staff will secure the gate at the end of each workday.

During daytime hours, a flagman will be present to direct drivers safely from Aerospace Blvd to and from the Vision Center. Please expect intermittent road closures while equipment and personnel move across the road to the field and back.

**Depending on the time of arrival, drivers should use the access road as directed by a flagman. To access the south entrance off Stewart Ave., follow the yellow markings.**

Parishioners may resume normal traffic patterns beginning February 28. However, Northrop Grumman will issue a follow-up notice on February 27 if the work schedule is impacted by weather.

### **Establishing Safety Zone and Temporary Closure of Tennis Courts**

In the early evening of Monday, February 23, our contractors will place barricades to cordon off a section of the parking lot nearest the skate park as a safety zone. The barricades will remain in place through Friday afternoon, February 27. The tennis courts will be temporarily closed from 6:30 a.m. on Tuesday, February 24 through Friday, February 27 at 6 p.m. to support our work zone.
