Subject: Upcoming Road Closure and Traffic Detour on March 9-11, 2026, at Arumdaun Presbyterian Church Vision Center; Temporary closure of Tennis Courts; Creation of safety zone in parking lot nearest Skate Park

Northrop Grumman is providing an updated schedule for our ongoing work at the Bethpage Community Park (Park). Starting Monday, March 9, 2026, from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m., the intersection of Access Road and Aerospace Blvd. will be closed through Wednesday afternoon, March 11, 2026.

- **On Monday, March 9, 2026, from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m.** all vehicles must follow the route (as shown in yellow below) and use the south entrance off Stewart Avenue to gain access to the Vision Center.
- **On Tuesday, March 10, 2026, and Wednesday, March 11, 2026, from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.**, all vehicles must again use the south entrance off Stewart Avenue (as shown in yellow below).



**Vision Center Drivers: Please use caution when using the South entrance of the Access Road and reduce your speed to and from the Vision Center as the road will be utilized for two-way traffic during our work hours. Parishioners can resume normal traffic March 12.**

Northrop Grumman staff will open the gate to the south access road entrance at 11 a.m. on March 9, and 7 a.m. on March 10-11.

Our security staff will lock the south gate on Stewart Avenue at 6 p.m. once the Aerospace Blvd Access Road is reopened at the end of each day of this work period.

This work enables our contractors to temporarily install a large crane and safety equipment to support the removal of the Phase 2 In-Situ Thermal Remedy (ISTR) system. The crane schedule is subject to change based on progress and unforeseen delays (i.e., weather or mechanical).

### **Establishing Safety Zone and Temporary Closure of Tennis Courts**

- In the early evening of Sunday, March 8, our contractors will place barricades to cordon off a section of the parking lot nearest the skate park as a safety zone. The barricades will remain in place through Thursday afternoon, March 12.
- The tennis courts will be temporarily closed from 6:30 a.m. on Monday, March 9 through Wednesday, March 11 at 6 p.m. to support our work zone.
