PSE&G power activation to well vault meters Inspection of leak detection system manholes

February 3 community presentation available on website Routine groundwater monitoring information added to website

Due to inclement weather today, we have rescheduled our work with PSE&G to activate power to our two remaining well vault electrical meters.

- Remedial Well 20 (RW-20) east of William Street on the utility corridor
- Remedial Well 22 (RW-22) east of Broadway on the utility corridor

You may observe our contractor working with two trucks at those locations to connect electrical power from the poles to the meters supporting the wells. We expect the work to take one day at each location.

In addition, you should expect to see us working along the residential street piping route as we inspect the leak detection manholes as part of our quality controls leading to system start up in the summer. We will follow up with additional schedule information in the next few weeks for the final installation of that system.

I want to thank everyone who attended our February 3 community update. The <u>presentation</u> has been posted to our project web site. We have also added a new element to our site which outlines <u>Northrop Grumman's Routine Groundwater Monitoring Program.</u>
