Subject: Electrical work to occur on William St, Emma St and S. Pershing Ave on March 16

Northrop Grumman is providing this progress report to you on our activities in support of the RW-21 groundwater treatment system project and other associated environmental activities.

Northrop Grumman contractors will conduct electrical work at three of our leak detection system manholes located on William Street (at Herman Avenue); Emma Street (between John Street and Park Avenue); and on South Pershing Avenue (at Totten Street) on Thursday, March 16, 2023, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. (weather dependent). You should expect to see several workers and two work vehicles.

We ask that residents and local landscapers avoid parking vehicles within 20 feet of these work zones during the daytime work hours. Once the work zone is clear, residents can relocate their vehicles back in those areas.

Due to project priorities, we are rescheduling the work that was planned for today on a Verizon/PSEG pole located nearest to 111 South Sheridan Avenue and at our leak detection system manhole located closest to 113 South Sheridan Avenue. We have removed the work zone traffic cones due to the change of schedule. As soon as that revised schedule is available, we will communicate it to you.
