Well development and groundwater treatment system building construction continues
Routine groundwater sampling and water level measurements underway
Well upgrades along our access road south of Bethpage Park to start Monday

Northrop Grumman is providing this progress report to you on our activities in support of the RW-21 groundwater treatment system project and other associated environmental activities.

RW-21 Treatment System well development continues

Our field teams continue to ready our three extraction wells for operation and start-up later this summer. You should expect to see our crews working in our work zones during business hours.

Routine groundwater sampling and water level measurements underway

Our routine groundwater sampling and water level measurement program continues throughout the month of May at various locations. Residents near our work locations receive notifications.

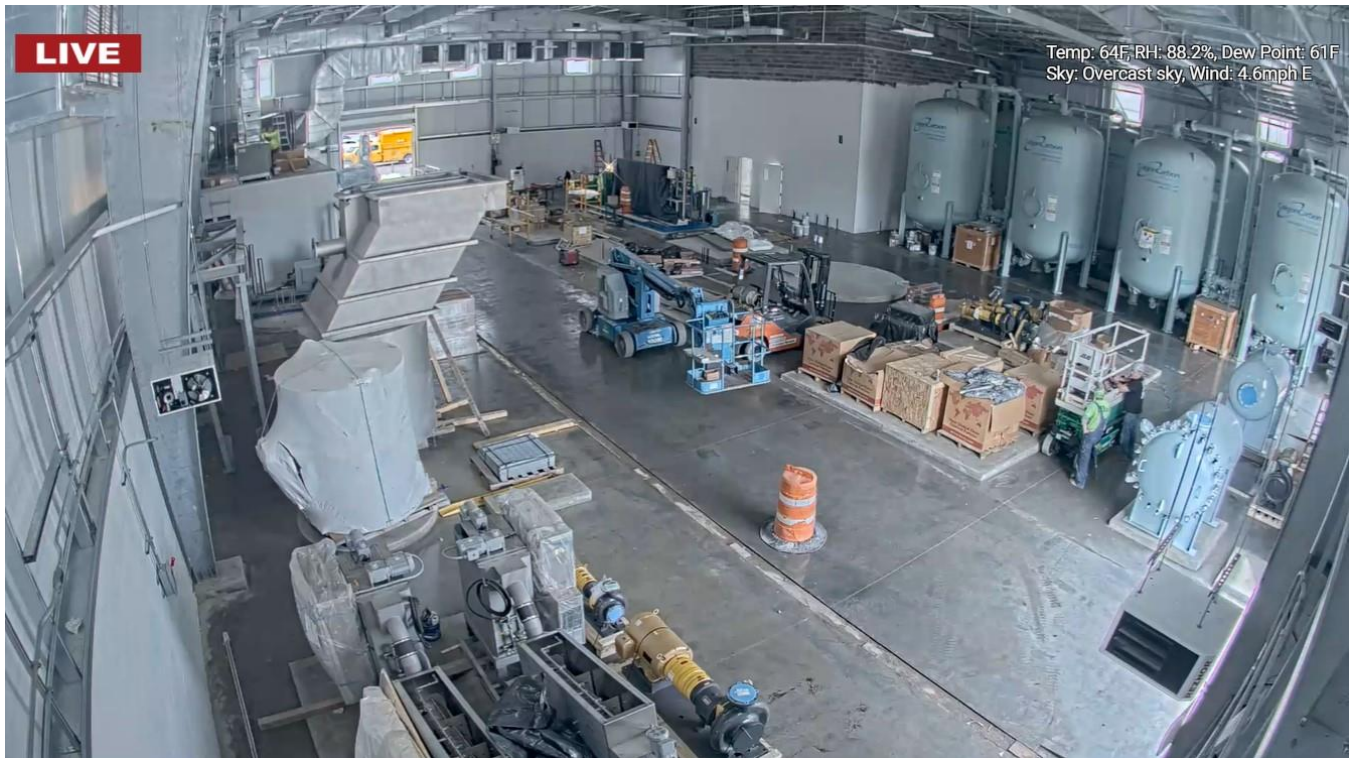
Well upgrades along Northrop Grumman's access road south of Bethpage Community Park



Starting this Monday, our contractors mobilized equipment to begin conducting work along our access road from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday until May 27. They will be upgrading several wells and installing piping in support of our onsite treatment system (see image). You should expect to see field personnel conducting construction operations with a small excavator, water truck, equipment trailer, and work vehicles on Northrop Grumman property. The OU3 system has been operation for several decades.

Groundwater treatment system construction continues

We continue to make solid progress on the construction of the groundwater treatment system. The interior system construction is pictured below.
