Subject: RW-20 well mechanical equipment installation to begin Tuesday, July 13, 2021

Northrop Grumman's contractors will begin the installation of the mechanical systems to support the operation of the RW-20 extraction well (well hatch is installed on the north side of William Street just east of Broadway) beginning the morning of Tuesday, July 13, 2021.

On Tuesday and Thursday, you will see several of our contractors and three work vehicles at the location during work hours (7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.).

We ask all homeowners, their guests and local vendors (such as landscaping vehicles) to avoid parking on William Street between Broadway and North Windhorst Avenue.

We will have traffic controls in place during work hours and want to ensure the safety of residents' vehicles as well as our contractors as they conduct their work in the street.

We will return to the site to install additional elements of the system over the next few months. We will advise you of each activity via a project memo before it occurs.
