**Subject:** Requirement to temporarily relocate vehicles parked on Sophia Street July 12 and on

North Herman Avenue July 12 or July 13

Northrop Grumman's contractors will begin scoring (cutting) the asphalt along the north side of Sophia Street (between North Herman Avenue and the utility corridor) beginning the morning of Monday, July 12, 2021 to support the installation of piping for the RW-21 groundwater treatment system project.

We ask all homeowners, their guests and local vendors (such as landscaping vehicles) to temporarily move vehicles off the street:

- Sophia Street: East of North Herman Avenue (both the north and south sides of the street) on July 12
- North Herman Avenue: north of Sophia Street to William Street (east side of the street only) on July 12
- North Herman Avenue: north of William Street to Emma Street (west side of the street only) on July 13

We want to ensure the safety of residents' vehicles as well as our contractors as they conduct their work in the streets on July 12 and 13.
