Subject: Theft, vandalism and trespassing at RW-22 well development location (greenway)
Schedule through July 15

Photos captured by our newly installed surveillance system continue to show children and adults engaging in trespassing activities. The perimeter fence was knocked down and sustained a fair amount of damage. The portasan was also knocked over and footprints were observed on the Frac tank.



In response to this continued theft, vandalism and trespassing at the RW-22 well development location (greenway), overnight security has been secured.

As previously mentioned, we have contacted the Nassau County Police Department 8th Precinct POP Unit, have filed another report and will be providing them with a copy of all photos. We ask that parents and members of the community remind their children and other young people that it is against the law to trespass in designated work zones and tamper with equipment and steal materials that are the property of others. They could also be injured in our work zone and parents would not be aware of their children's location.

Our schedule through July 15 is as follows:

Friday, July 8: Pipeline testing will continue until 8pm. This work involves a small team of 2-3 people on South Sheridan Avenue.

Monday, July 11 - Friday, July 15: Roadway striping layout will be performed on Hickey Blvd. at Central Avenue and is scheduled for one day during the week of July 15. County contractor, Safety Markings, will perform the work. All work is weather dependent.
