

***RW-21 Project Pipeline and Seaman Avenue Paving Notification
June 19, 2020 (weather permitting)***

This notice provides an update on our New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC)-approved project to treat offsite groundwater. We have completed the installation of the RW-21 pipeline segment on Seaman Avenue east. This work was completed 10 days ahead of schedule.

Based on discussions with our contractor, Posillico, we anticipate repaving our work area on the south bound lane of Seaman Avenue east from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. on June 19, 2020 (weather permitting).

We will have traffic control personnel on site to allow local traffic in one lane. The newly paved area along Seaman Ave and Town Lot B-2 will be coned off overnight to allow the paving to cool and re-opened the next day.

Equipment you should expect to see

Milling machine will be used to remove the temporary asphalt and make clean edges to the excavation area. A paving machine will be used to apply the new asphalt.

Worksite safety

Experienced, specially trained, qualified personnel conduct all work in accordance with a Health and Safety Plan that meets or exceeds requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA). In addition, we are following all recommended guidelines from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and New York State as it relates to COVID-19 and social distancing.
